Re: Consideration of Waiver and Modification of YSCD Graduation Requirements

for Class of 2021

Background Information:

Last year the Oregon Department of Education reduced its 24 credit graduation requirement to 22 to account for the impact of school closures related to COVID-19. YCSD responded by aligning the district requirement to match the state requirement of 22.

At that time districts were also directed to put plans in place to support juniors (Class of 2021) to recover credit and stay on track for their graduation in 2021.

Graduation Pathways Guidance has been released and this year, for the class of 2021, ODE directs a return to the 24 credit requirement for graduation.

Graduation requirements for YCSD are outlined in Board Policy IKF. YCSD requires 26 credits for its regular diploma-two more than is required to meet Oregon's minimum requirement.

The high school administration notes that, due to the pandemic and the challenges with Comprehensive Distance Learning, they have experienced significant hardship in implementing their usual systems of support for some students to achieve final elective credits toward the 26 credit requirement. They are asking the Board to consider waiving the 26 credit requirement for the class of 2021 and making the state minimum the graduation standard for this year. The requirement would return to the YCSD established 26 credit requirement in 2022.

Recommendation: Consider waiving the YSCD 26 credit graduation requirement and adopting the state minimum graduation requirement for the Class of 2021.
